The SAHF is the only source of funding for medical equipment purchases for the Sault Area Hospital.

The SAHF has been in existence since 1977 and every year fundraises for various equipment needs through a variety of programs. New equipment is crucial to attract and retain new healthcare professionals.

Donations made to the Foundation do not go towards the hospital's operational costs.

The Foundation is a separate entity, with a separate budget from the hospital with our own Board of Directors.

Our work is never done – year after year there is new equipment, education and information technology needs.
