- The Foundation is planning for the future and preparing for our move to the new hospital in early 2011.

- We are planning today for our hospital's needs of tomorrow. A special "Building A Bridge to the Future" Legacy Society donor wall was unveiled last September and will be brought to the new hospital.

Some key messages that we would like to reinforce with you are that all funds raised by the Foundation are specifically earmarked for equipment or education needs and cannot be used to support "operational costs" of the hospital. We are a separate entity, with a separate budget from the hospital, whose founding and ongoing purpose is to raise funds for the hospital.

We would also like to reiterate that the Foundation is the only source of funding to support vital ongoing medical equipment needs for SAH patients across the Algoma District on an annual basis. Year after year, there are new equipment needs that we will continue to fundraise for. These needs will continue even after we move into the new hospital.

In the face of tough economic times, we would like to express our heartfelt thanks and appreciation for your generosity and compassion and respectfully ask for your continued consideration and support as we look to the horizon. You truly help to make our success stories possible!

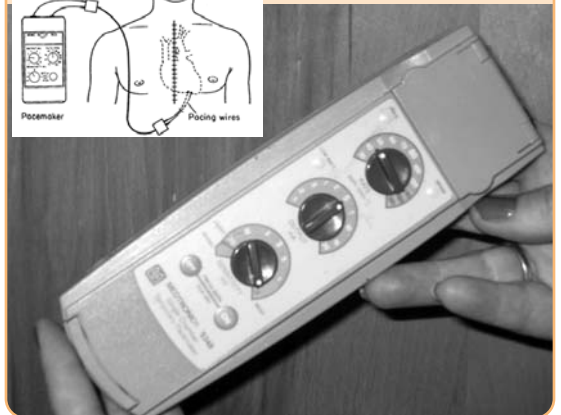
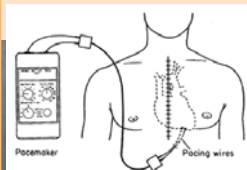
The **Glidescope** is a life-saving, state-of-the-art video camera attached to a video screen which can be positioned in the throat to visualize the airway. It allows easier endotracheal intubation while placing critically ill patients on life support.

In addition, it allows us to remove foreign bodies in the airway and assess for epiglottitis - a potentially fatal throat infection. It is also a very useful tool in instructing resident and medical students in the emergency airway management since it projects a video on to a monitor.



Temporary Pacemaker

A pacemaker is an electronic device which helps your heart beat regularly. Most often, pacemakers are used to speed up the heart rate when it is too slow. Pacemakers also can be used to slow the heart rate if it is too fast, or help it beat regularly, if it is irregular. An abnormal heart rate or rhythm may occur after open heart surgery, after a heart attack or may also occur with other types of heart disease. The temporary pacemaker is used until a permanent pacemaker is placed or changed.
